Farmington Town Board Decision On Proposal to Add Territory to the Chain O'Lakes Sanitary District #1 (2019)

Findings of Fact

- 1. A proposal to add territory to the Chain O'Lakes Sanitary District #1 has been received by the Town Board from the Sanitary District Commissioner. A map showing the territory to be added to the sanitary district is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. (Exhibit B)
- 2. On May 8, 2019, a public hearing on the proposed addition of territory to the sanitary district was scheduled and conducted, pursuant to ss 60.71(4) Wis. Stats.
- 3. The proposed work is necessary. Public health, safety, convenience and welfare will be promoted by adding the territory to the sanitary district.
- 4. The property to be added to the sanitary district will be benefitted by the sanitary district.

Order

Upon the above findings, the Farmington Town Board hereby orders that the additional territory shall be added to and become part of the Chain O'Lakes Sanitary District #1. The boundaries are hereby established in accordance with the legal description and the survey showing the area to be added to the Chain O'Lakes Sanitary District #1 (Exhibit A and Exhibit B)

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That copies of this order adding territory to the sanitary district shall be filed with the Department of Natural Resources and re4corded with the Register of Deeds for Waupaca County.
