Ordinance 10/17/19(2019)

An Ordinance to Adopt an Amendment to the Comprehensive Plan for the Town of Farmington

The Town Board of the Town of Farmington, Waupaca County Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to Section(s) 62.23, 61.35, 60.22(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Farmington is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in Sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2: The Town Board, by the enactment of an ordinance, formally adopted the document titled Ordinance #08-07-07(2007) An Ordinance to Adopt the Town of Farmington Year 2030 Comprehensive Plan on August 7, 2007.

Section 3: The Plan Commission, by a majority vote of the entire Commission at a meeting held on September 11, 2019 recommended to the Town Board the adoption of an amendment to change the land use designation of part of parcel #05 34 56 14 proposed lot 4 located on County Road Q from Agriculture to Commercial on the future land use map adopted as part of the comprehensive plan.

Section 4: The Town published or posted a Class 1 public notice and held a public hearing regarding the plan amendment.

Section 5: The Town Board of Farmington, Waupaca Wisconsin hereby adopts the proposed plan amendment.

Section 6: The Town Clerk is directed to send a copy of this ordinance and the plan amendment to the parties listed in Section 66.1001(4)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 7: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the full membership of the Town Board and publication or posting as required by law.
