RESOLUTION 91-1 (1991)

WHEREAS, 1989 Wisconsin Act 335, effective May 11, 1990, has as a stated goal to reduce the amount of solid waste as presently being landfilled by the development of programs that reduce, reuse and recycle waste; and,

WHEREAS, 1989 Wisconsin Act 335 requires that each municipality be under an effective recycling program as outlined by the Act; and,

WHEREAS, a County may become the "Responsible Unit" for the development and implementation of an effective recycling by adoption of a County enabling resolution and/or by designation under an agreement with a municipality; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Farmington deems it to be in their best interest to join together to form an intergovernmental County Recycling Program for the collection, transportation, and processing of recyclable materials; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Farmington concurs with the "County/Municipal Recycling Agreement" written jointly by the County and Municipalities of Waupaca County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Farmington recommends that the County Board of Supervisors enact a resolution designating the County as the "Responsible Unit" as defined within 1989 Wisconsin Act 335; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon enactment by the County Board of Supervisors of said resolution, the Town of Farmington, agrees to enter into agreement with the County to provide an effective recycling program as defined in the "County/Municipal Recycling Agreement".
