NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the resolution from April 4, 1950 is rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That we, the town electors of the Town of Farmington, Waupaca County, Wisconsin, being duly assembled at the annual town meeting on April 21, 2003, do hereby authorize the Town Board to exercise village powers pursuant to §§60.10(2)(c) and 60.22(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That this resolution authorizes the town board to exercise powers relating to villages and conferred on village boards under Ch. 61, Wisconsin Statutes, except those powers which conflict with statutes relating to towns and town boards.
